## **Role overview**

The Walworth Living Room is a social venture, led and supported by Pembroke House, a community organisation based in Walworth. We aim to grow the capacity for community members to increase and strengthen their social connections, to build stronger relationships and a sense of belonging within the community. We are seeking to contract with a friendly, well-organised person to provide hosting services in the Living Room. That role will welcome people to the space, help them connect to each other, ensure activities are delivered and provide food service in our cafe. The host will be an all round extra pair of hands in the space, assisting staff to ensure the space is safe for all to use.

- ACTIVITY DELIVERY: Ensure all activities are set up, cleaned up and delivered on schedule. Provide all necessary administrative support for activities and coordinate volunteers where needed.
- ENGAGEMENT: Provide a friendly, safe and welcoming environment for all visitors. Provide outreach and marketing support to draw more people into the space, which could include distributing fliers and posting on social media.
- FOOD AND DRINK SERVICE: Provide food and drink service support in the cafe, including set up, clean up, serving food, preparing coffee and processing sales.
- FOOD SAFETY AND HEALTH AND SAFETY: Ensure all food safety standards are adhered to in the cafe and the Community Fridge.

You will have excellent communication and listening skills as well as an open and friendly attitude in order to do this well.
